Northney Marina Cod/Winter Species Competition Rules 2019

- 1. Acceptance of your entry is on the understanding that you are agreeing to fish by the rules stated below and that infringement of any value may lead to disqualification.
- 2. Boats will leave Northney Marina at 0800 and return by 1700.
- 3. Lines down will be called when the last boat calls "anchor down".
- 4. Angler's places on the boat must be drawn at the start of each day. THE SKIPPERS WORD IS FINAL.
- 5. Competitors may only have 2 rods assembled, only one of these rods may have terminal tackle fitted at any one time.
- 6. This is a 2 hook event, a pennel rig counts as 2 hooks, treble hooks are barred.
- 7. There will be no casting inside the boat, any casting will be done outside the boat and under arm only. The angler must make others aware when casting.
- 8. No uptide casting
- 9. Each boat will have a dedicated member of the crew to be used for scoring only (not anglers)
- 10. The longest cod will win a prize each day
- 11. Points will be scored depending on species, there will be a points system in operation on each boat.
- 12. Should a fish be hooked by more than 1 angler it is the hook that is in the mouth that takes the score, should both hooks be in the mouth then the fish score will not count for either angler.
- 13. Anglers are to supply their own bait, however Andy's baits will be at Northney Marina on both days selling bait.
- 14. We expect all anglers to respect the boat and the skipper that they are with, and we ask that you keep your area clean and help to wash down at the end of each day. A clean boat is a happy boat.
- 15. This is a no alcohol and no drugs competition, any anglers found with either will be removed from the competition
